- Stay overnight in Dublin.





Itinerary Day 2 (August 2, 2024) Dublin Sightseeing and Spiritual Exploration:


- Start your day with a hearty Irish breakfast at your hotel.

- In the evening, join for a spiritual ceremony, tapping into the energies of the Northern lands.



Day 4 (August 4, 2024) Free Day in Belfast:

- Today is yours to explore Belfast at your own pace. You can spend the day shopping for souvenirs at Victoria Square, exploring the botanical wonders of the Belfast Botanic Gardens, or wandering through the picturesque streets of the Cathedral Quarter.
- For those interested in history, you may visit the Ulster Museum or take a walking tour of Belfast's murals to learn about the city's political past.
- Alternatively, you can simply relax and soak in the atmosphere of this vibrant city.
- Stay overnight in Belfast.





Itinerary Day 5 (August 5, 2024) Day Trip to Giant's Causeway and Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge:

- After breakfast, depart Belfast for a day trip to the mystical Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its unique basalt columns.
- En route, stop at Dunseverick Castle to connect with the land's ancient energies.
- Explore the otherworldly landscape of the Giant's Causeway and brave the Carricka- Rede Rope Bridge for stunning views. Engage in ceremonial practices at each site visited, connecting with the energies and indigenous meanings.
- Return to Belfast in the evening and relax at your hotel.
- Stay overnight in Belfast.



Day 6 (August 6, 2024) Travel to Dublin:

- After breakfast, depart Belfast for Dublin.
- Along the way, visit the ancient Hill of Tara, the legendary seat of the High Kings of Ireland, and the nearby ruins of Trim Castle, one of the largest Norman castles in Ireland. Engage in ceremonial practices at each site visited, connecting with the energies and indigenous meanings.
- Arrive in Dublin in the afternoon and check into your hotel.
- Enjoy the evening at leisure, perhaps dining at a cozy pub or exploring the mystical atmosphere of the Hellfire Club ruins on Montpelier Hill.
- Stay overnight in Dublin.

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


Itinerary Day 7 (August 7, 2024) Visit to Newgrange and Spiritual Exploration:

- After breakfast, embark on a journey to Newgrange, a prehistoric monument located in County Meath, Ireland.
- Explore the ancient circular mound, stone passageway, and chambers inside, dating back to around 3200 BC.
- Experience the mystical atmosphere of Newgrange and its strong spiritual significance, associated with ancient Celtic rituals and beliefs.
- Conduct ceremonial practices at Newgrange, tapping into its mystical energy and connecting with the ancient spirits.
- Return to Dublin in the late evening and stay overnight.
